A key objective for Mary Potter Hospice's future service model is to build community capability to meet the increased need for palliative care services.

The new service model requires a structure that will support the community teams into the future. The Palliative care Triage CNS (TCNS) role is a new role that will provide one point of contact for community referrals and calls from health care providers, patients, families, whanau to ensure seamless and equitable admissions to community services.

The TCNS will screen, review and assess all referrals and allocate them to the appropriate Mary Potter Hospice services to ensure timely, coordinated care.

This role will report to the new Community Services Manager and will be integral member of the community management team.

We are looking for a strong team player capable of building relationships across teams. You will work at a level of advanced practice in palliative care with strong assessment, critical thinking and triage skills. You will demonstrate leadership qualities such as vision, openness, flexibility, emotional intelligence and integrity. Applicants need to have a recognised postgraduate qualification (or equivalent) in palliative care and ACP level 2 (working towards)
